The committee of five individuals reviewed and ranked proposals for a LIMS system submitted by two vendors: LabLite LLC and Indigo Technology. Each committee member considered the original proposal, supplemental information provided by request from each vendor, and information from the Zoom video conferences during which time each vendor was asked selected questions and was expected to demonstrate examples of their LIMS product and services.

The committee felt that both vendors had good products and services that would provide functional LIMS to our two laboratories.
