Late September	Notice of Intent to Award Services
Upon Award	Contract Negotiations Begin (upon intent to award)

MODIFIED SUBMISSION PROCESS

The following describes the modified submission process and new deadlines. Take note of the new dates and the new process:

July 17, 2017: Phase 1 submission deadline.

Vendors wishing to propose only software (not implementation) must submit by this deadline.

Vendors wishing to propose a combined bid (software and services) must submit the software portion of their response by this deadline. Indicate in an addendum this is the software response portion of a combined bid.

The software portion of combined bids must include cost information, as though it were a software-only bid.

Combined bids may include an addendum that indicates whether the vendor is willing to have the two halves of their combined proposal also considered as individual software and services proposals.

We will evaluate the software proposals and select the best fitting software packages (NOT software vendors). We will invite a vendor representing each of those packages to present the software package in-person at the Fayetteville campus. Vendors should note that being invited to present is not intended to confer special status on that vendor. If multiple vendors propose the same software package, we may invite the software manufacturer to demo the product, and therefore allowing a representative from other vendors who proposed the same software to attend the demo.

[August 4, 2017: Announce software selection.](#)

We will select a software package from those under consideration. We will not at this time select a vendor. If multiple vendors have proposed the selected software, all of those vendors remain in the running. The remaining phase 1 bidders will be excused from phase 1.

We will announce the selected software package. Any vendor, including those excused from phase 1, may offer a phase 2 bid to address the implementation requirements of the selected software, so long as they can meet the phase 2 requirements.

[August 21, 2017: Phase 2 submission deadline.](#)

Vendors wishing to propose implementation services for the selected software package must submit by this deadline.

Vendors wishing to propose a combined bid, who have survived the phase 1 selection, must submit the services portion of their response by this deadline. Indicate that this is the services response portion of a combined bid.

Combined bids may include an addendum that illustrates cost savings realized should we select the combined bid. Combined bids may include an addendum that indicates whether the vendor is willing have the two halves of their combined proposal also considered as individual software and services proposals.

We will evaluate the services proposals and invite the best fitting vendors to present their services proposal in-person at the Fayetteville campus.

September 18, 2017. Selection of software and services vendor(s), intent to award.

Based on our evaluation we will select either one vendor (for a combined bid), or a pair of vendors (for separate software and services bids). We will announce our intent to award and enter negotiations with the selected vendor(s). We will announce the award upon conclusion of negotiations, and final legislative review/approval.

Time is of the essence in all respects concerning this process and we appreciate your attention and cooperation moving forward.
